Co-curricular Component:

Students will be required to accumulate 60 points in order to complete this component of the IKE program. In order to earn the units that are given for each activity students will need to complete the Activities tracking sheet and write the specified essay for each event. The Activities tracking sheet will be handed in to the IKE Administrators in the International Programs and Services office; whereas, the essays will be uploaded into the IKE ANGEL group for review.

Essay Guidelines:

EVENTS:

Content: Short description of the event, clear explanation of why the event was of international value.

Length: 1 to 2 pages typed, 12 pt font, Times New Roman, double spaced, one inch margins on all sides

CLUBS & ORGANIZATIONS:

Content: Short paragraph about why participating in the club or organization was of international value

Length: 1 paragraph, 1 page maximum, 12 pt font, Times New Roman, double spaced, one inch margins on all sides.

VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES:

Content: Short description of volunteer activities, explanation of why it was of international value

Length: 1 page maximum, 12 pt font, Times New Roman, double spaced, one inch margins on all sides

LANGUAGE TABLES & OTHER MODERN LANGUAGE ACTIVITIES:

Content: Short paragraph about why participating the activity was of international value

Length: 1 paragraph, 1 page maximum, 12 pt font, Times New Roman, double spaced, one inch margins on all sides.

Submission Instructions:

All essays must be submitted by posting them to the IKE group on ANGEL.
