Co-Curricular Activities IKE Unit Values

Students will be required to accumulate 60 points in order to complete this component of the IKE program. In order to earn the units that are given for each activity, students will need to complete the Activities tracking sheet and write the specified essay for each event. The Activities tracking sheet will be handed in to the IKE Administrators in the International Programs and Services office; whereas, the essays will be uploaded into the IKE ANGEL group for review.

Events: concerts, plays, art exhibits, lectures, films, seminars, conferences, brown bags, etc.

5 UNITS: Each attendance (for being a member of the audience) e.g. attending any event with an international theme or topic or events sponsored by the International Programs & Services Office, various departments, international studies, etc.

10 UNITS: Performer or presenter

Clubs and Organizations

5 UNITS PER SEMESTER: Member

10 UNITS PER SEMESTER: Officer

5 UNITS: Participation in a single program or activity sponsored by a club or organization

Volunteer activities:

30 UNITS PER SEMESTER: Semester long commitment, e.g. conversation partner in Intensive English, etc.

15 UNITS: Half semester commitment

10 UNITS: Leadership position

5 UNITS: Single activity

Language Tables:

20 UNITS PER SEMESTER: Attendance of language tables at least 10 for full credit

10 UNITS PER SEMESTER: Fewer than 10 time of attendance
