Campus Privilege Fee Descriptions

<u>Intercollegiate Athletics Fee</u> funds a portion of the operating costs of Intercollegiate Athletics, assists in funding scholarships that are given to the student athletes to support their cost of attendance at the university, and provides students free admissions to all regular season intercollegiate athletic competitions.

<u>Student Health Fee</u> funds the operation, staffing and services of the Bryant Student Health Center on campus, providing a wide range of physical health and mental health services to students.

<u>Union Operations Fee</u> funds the operation, staffing, and services of the Overman Student Center.

<u>Union Program Fee</u> funds the operations and services of the Campus Activities Center and the programming activities of the Gorilla Activity Board (GAB).

Student Recreation Fee funds the staffing programs offered by the Student Recreation Center.

<u>Parking Fee</u> funds the operation of parking services on the campus, the maintenance, of the parking lot surfaces, and any development of additional parking.

<u>One Card Fee</u> funds the operation of the university identification card program used by students, faculty, and staff for identification as well as service and program access on campus.

<u>Educational Opportunity Fund Fee</u> funds a range of programs and services to include tutoring, student success services, scholarships, and student employment opportunities.

<u>Facilities Expansion and Renovation Fee</u> funds the repayment of the debt undertaken to construct an addition to the Overman Student Center, a portion of the construction of the Robert W. Plaster Indoor Even Center, and a portion of the construction of the Bicknell Family Center for the Arts.

<u>Overman Renovation Fee</u> funds the repayment of the debt undertaken to renovate a portion of the Overman Student Center.
